

What You Should Know About Bridal Shower Invitations

Wording is an important consideration if you are planning to send out bridal shower invitations. You will have to consider factors such as how to inform the guests about the theme if you have one, what poems to use, and what tone to take with the invitation. These factors are important in ensuring that the bridal shower invitations will stand out for the receivers.

Some of the details that should be included in bridal shower invitations are the full name of the bride, and in some cases of the groom, the date and time of the event, the location, the RSVP name and number, and the date to RSVP by. You may also want to include in the bridal shower invitations information about where the bride is registered, the date of the wedding itself, and the name of the host. Showers that have a specific theme should have the bridal shower invitations worded so as to reflect this information. If you are planning to make the shower a surprise, the receivers must also be informed of this, along with what time the bride is expected to arrive.

Bridal shower invitations can either take on a traditional, a casual, or a general tone. This of course will depend on the type of bridal shower you will be holding, as well as the personal preferences of the bride. The general type of bridal shower invitations is by far the simplest, and can be nothing more than a message of invitation, as well as the name of the bride and the time and place of the event. A traditional message will tend to be more formal, with an appropriately worded invitation, along with the name of the bride, the date and time of the party, as well as its location. Traditional bridal shower invitations also typically mention the required attire, and include a mention of the name of the person who is hosting the party.

Casual bridal shower invitations tend to be more informal and even "cutesy" in its approach, and may take on the form of a simple rhyme. Details of the shower such as where and when it will be held, as well as the brides name should of course be included as well. A themed bridal shower often requires a different approach. Bridal shower invitations for these types of events should reflect the specific theme, and the invitation should be worded to include the nature of the event, as well as mention its theme. This is essential if you expect people to attend the event in costume.
