Take some time to check the content of the other bloggers who use that submit blog directory. Do the other blogs bring good commentary with integrity? The only thing worse than no exposure is bad exposure and you do not want your hard work being associated with less than good writing and being disregarded by potential readers. Once you find a quality submit blog directory, take advantage of all the great things that directory can do for you.
